ITEM II POWERS AND DUTIES V.T.C.A. §49.200

1. CONSIDER AMENDING DISTRICT VACATION POLICY TO ROUND VACATION HOURS TO TWO DECIMAL PLACES

Hector Ortiz discussed the District's vacation policy and indicated that the policy rounds to four decimal places and QuickBooks rounds to two. This creates a minimal

ITEM III FISCAL MATTERS V.T.C.A §49.300

1. CONSIDER AGREEMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF DISTRICT'S RADIOS

The General Manager presented two proposals for the replacement of the District's eight radios. These radios transmit signals from remote sites to the plant and the data is used in operating the facilities. The quotes were for \$16,810 and \$13,719.40. Hector Ortiz asked the Board to approve the purchase for the higher amount as staff was still researching the quote for lower amount and a meeting was scheduled for 10/21/2025. Once all details are evaluated, a decision will be made to purchase the radios from one vendor. A motion was made by Randy Biddle to approve the purchase of the radios for \$16,810. This motion was seconded by James Cornelius. All directors voted aye.

2. CONSIDER AGREEMENT FOR THE RECONDITIONING OF HIGH SERVICE PUMP MOTOR #3

Hector Ortiz presented five quotes for the reconditioning of high service pump #3. A recommendation was made to select the lowest bidder, Shermco in the amount of \$20,719 for the work. A motion was made by Jack Denman to award the reconditioning of the motor to Shermco. The motion was seconded by Mike McKenzie. All directors voted ave.

3. CONSIDER AGREEMENT TO RECONDITION RAW WATER PUMP #1

Hector Ortiz presented three quotes for reconditioning raw water pump #1. A recommendation was made to award the reconditioning work to C&P in the amount of \$109,810. A motion was made by Randy Biddle to award the work to C&P Pump. This motion was seconded by Neil Harris. All directors voted aye.
